Statement by Governor Brewer Regarding Sen. David Braswell, Candidate for Legislative District 6 Senate

PHOENIX, AZ – Governor Jan Brewer made the following statement today:

“Senator Braswell has been very supportive of my efforts to fight illegal immigration, address the state’s budget crisis and create jobs. I support his candidacy for the state Senate.”
